

## COMPLAINT OF REPRISAL

under *The Public Interest Disclosure Act* (the Act)

Under section 36(1) of the Act, no person shall take or direct a reprisal against a public servant or former public servant because the public servant has, in good faith:

- (a) sought advice about making a disclosure from the designated officer or permanent head of the government institution which he or she is employed or the commissioner;
- (b) made a disclosure;
- (c) co-operated in an investigation pursuant to this act; or
- (d) declined to participate in wrongdoing.

If a public servant or former public servant alleges that a reprisal has been taken or directed against him or her, the public servant or former public servant may make a written complaint to the Public Interest Disclosure Commissioner respecting the matter.
